1. With this privacy policy we inform you according to Art. 13 GDPR on data processing in our company Schäfer Elektronik GmbH

2. We process the following personal data:
 - First and last name, title, academic title if applicable
 - Postal address / s
 - Phone / n
 - if necessary
 - telefax number / n
 - Email addresses
 - gender
 - Information needed for proper contracting
3. We process personal data for the purposes of
 - Proper execution of the customer relationship including correspondence,
 - Fulfillment of our contractual and legal obligations and
 - Processing in the context of mutual claims arising from the contractual relationships (e.g. billing, performance, compensation and liability claims, etc.).
4. The legal basis for data processing in our company is Art. 6 (1) Subparagraphs a and b and c (GDPR)
5. The transfer of personal data to third parties will only proceed with your prior agreement. We provide personal data in the context of the contractual relationship to the following recipients:
 - Processors (e.g. data centers, IT service providers, printing service providers, disposal companies, etc.), whose services we use.
6. Data transfer to third countries (non-EEA countries) takes place only as far as necessary for the execution of the contractual relationship or you have given consent or that this is otherwise permitted by law. In this case we take Measurements to ensure the protection of your data, for example through contractual arrangements. We only provide to recipients who protect your data according to the regulations GDPR for transmission to third countries (Articles 44 to 49 GDPR).
7. Your personal data will be stored by Schaefer only as long as it is required to complete contractual agreements in line with the legal retention periods.

8. You have the following rights as "data subject" whose data we process:

Right to information according to Art. 15 GDPR

Right to correction under Art. 16 GDPR

Right to be deleted ("Forgotten") according to Art. 17 GDPR

Right to restriction of processing according to Art. 18 GDPR

Right to transfer your data in a structured, common and machine-readable format according to Art. 20 GDPR

As far as we base the processing for specific purposes of your personal information with your consent, you *have* the right under Article 7 (3) GDPR to revoke your consent at any time. Upon receipt of your cancellation we will process the data for the purpose for which you have given us your consent. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

Right to objection: If we use your personal data in order to safeguard legitimate interests for the purposes of Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR, according to Art. 21 (1) GDPR, the right to objection to this processing for reasons that arise from your particular situation which is given. Against processing for purposes of direct mail you can disagree acc. to Art. 21 para. 2 GDPR at any time without reason contradict. To exercise your right to object, an Informal message to us by e-mail is enough: mail@schaeferpowers.de with the indication of which Data processing you contradict.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the right to complain under Art. 77 Paragraph 1 GDPR at a data protection supervisory authority (usually country representative for Privacy and freedom of information). The complaint may be filed with the supervisory authority which is placed at the place of your habitual residence, work or the one which could be responsible for the alleged infringement.
